



## How-to guide: Use ArcGIS Pro to Verify Your CViz®Pro Active License Status

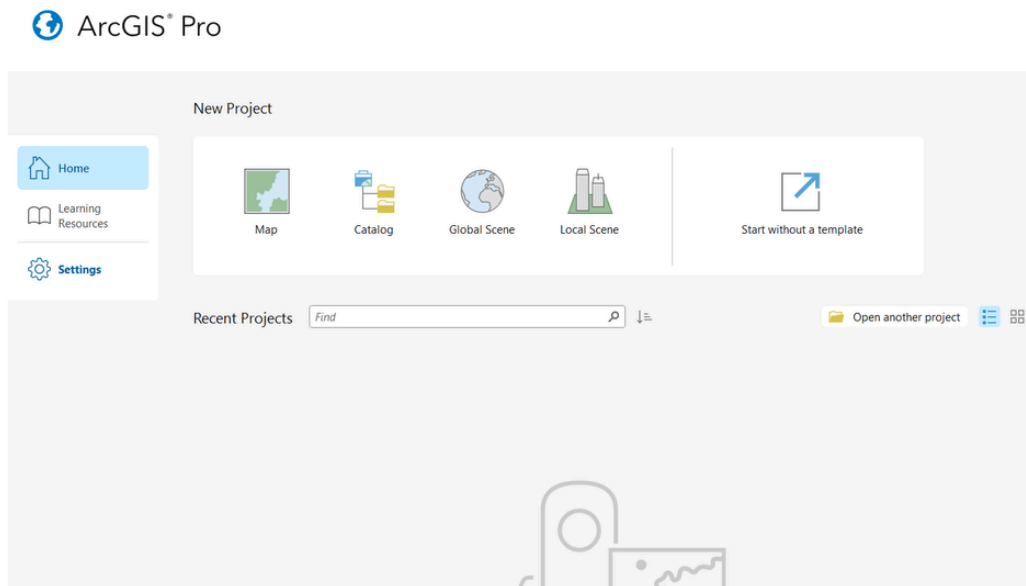
The following steps will help you use ArcGIS Pro to check your license status, so you can verify that you have an “Active” CViz®Pro License within the ArcGIS Pro application.

### Verification Steps

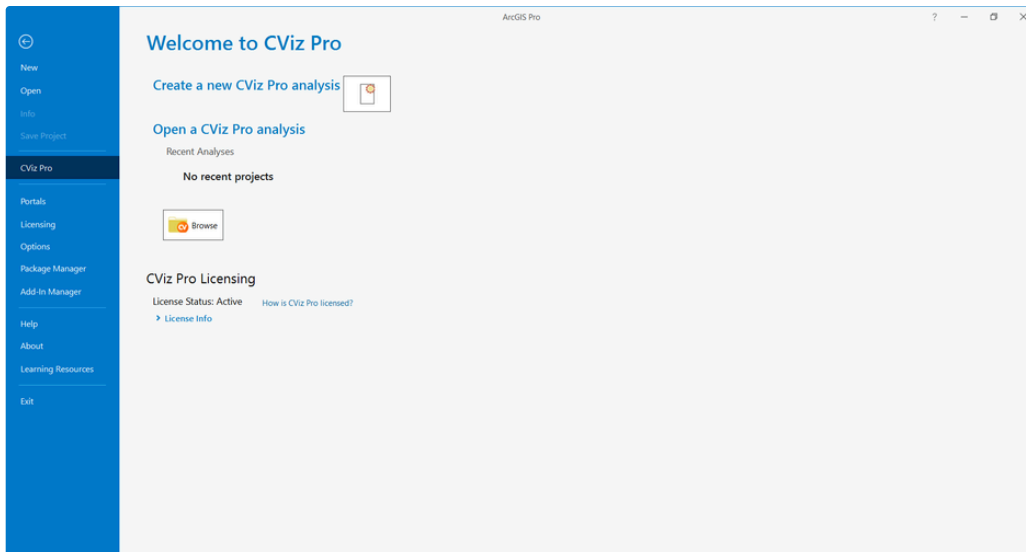
1. Open the **ArcGIS Pro** application on your computer.



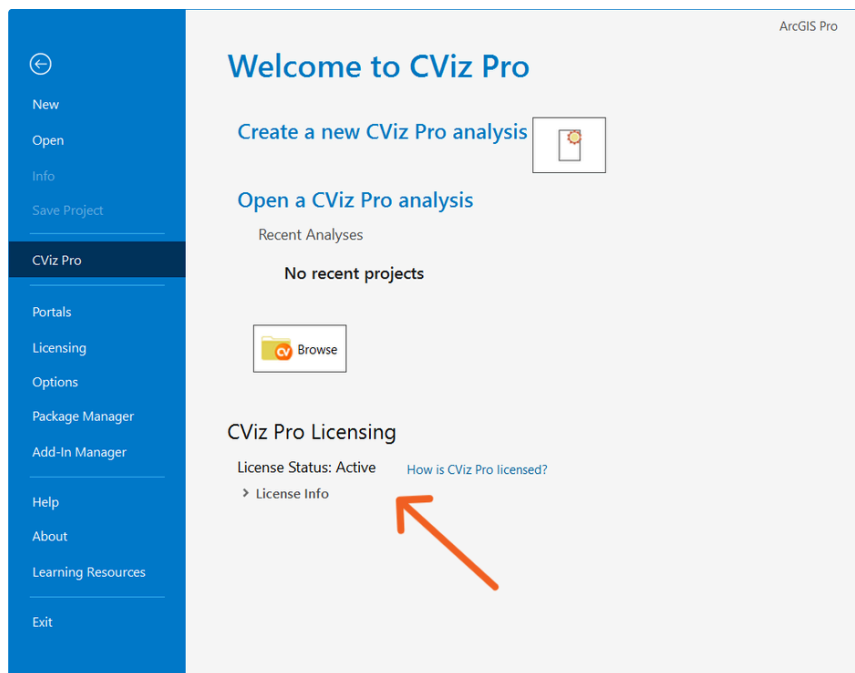
2. Select the **“Settings”** option on the left panel.



3. Select the **“CViz Pro”** option on the left panel and you will see a “Welcome to CViz Pro” Screen.



4. **Verify** your **“License Status”** in the section labeled “CViz Pro Licensing”. You will see a corresponding status next to the field labeled, “License Status”. If your status is active, it will show “Active”.



5. **Select** the **“License Info”** drop down arrow, to see more license information. Note in this example, the License ID has been blocked out. If you were to verify on your application, you will also see the License ID # associated with your account.
